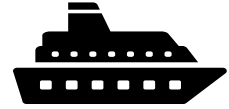

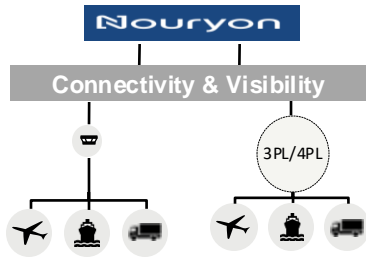

Hybrid Model Overview

Adaption to requirements obtaining the benefits of both Direct and External logistics management

A hybrid model is considered the best option:



Nouryon in direct control over key shipping lanes

- For higher Volume, higher criticality scenarios, manage pre & post leg + ocean carriers directly and leverage Nouryon organizational capacity
- Strong relationship with the carrier will limit third party impacts and provide first-hand information in case of issues.



Leverage freight forwarders' capabilities to execute lanes with lower business impact

- Lower volume/lower criticality lanes that do not warrant the overhead cost of direct Nouryon control
- Freight forwarders extended network facilitates the end-to-end shipments execution, by managing all pre-legs and resolving all exceptions related.

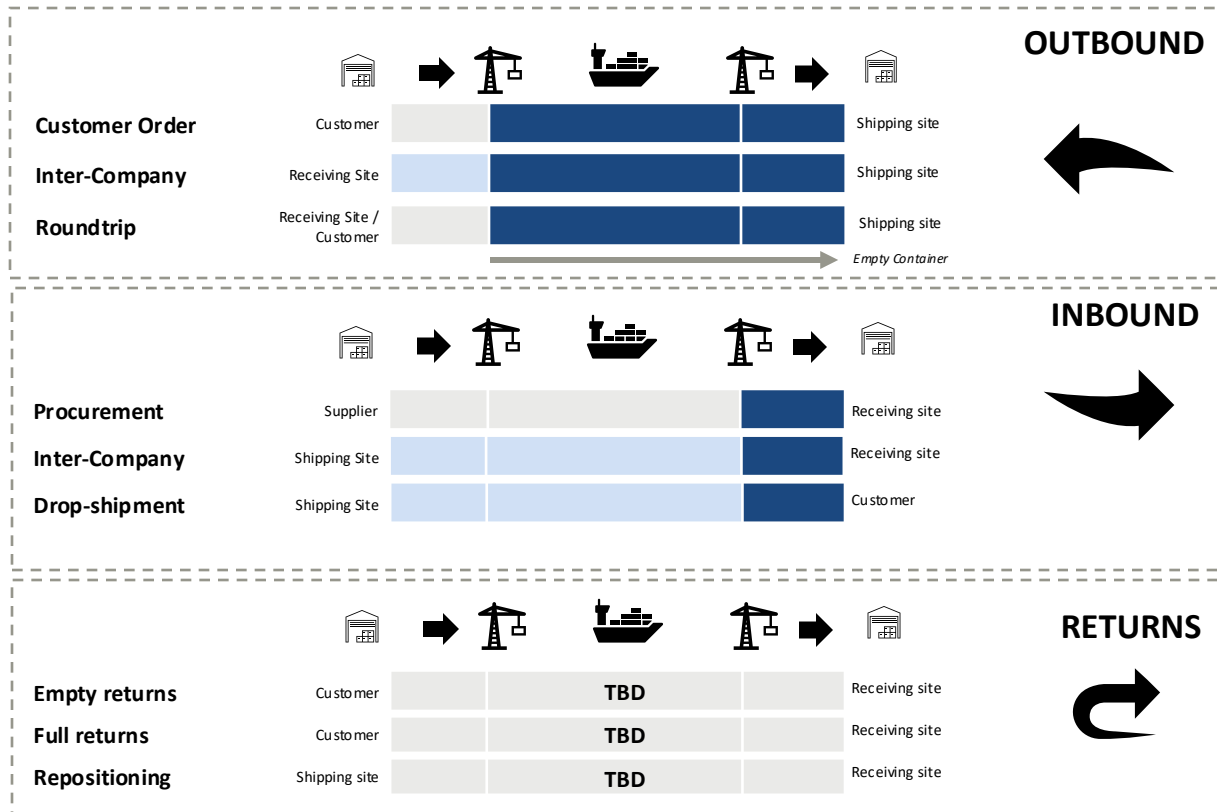


Connectivity platform to enable scalability and flexibility.

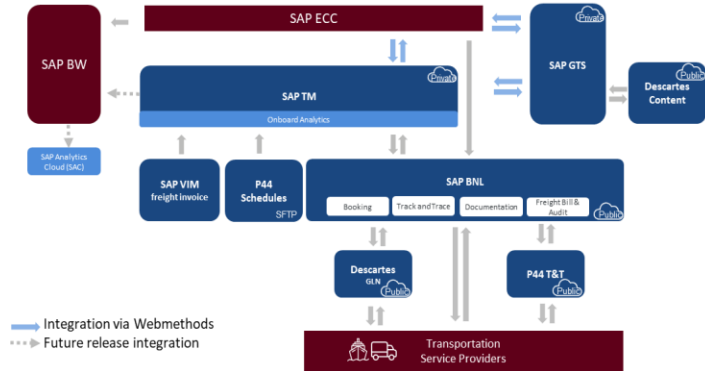

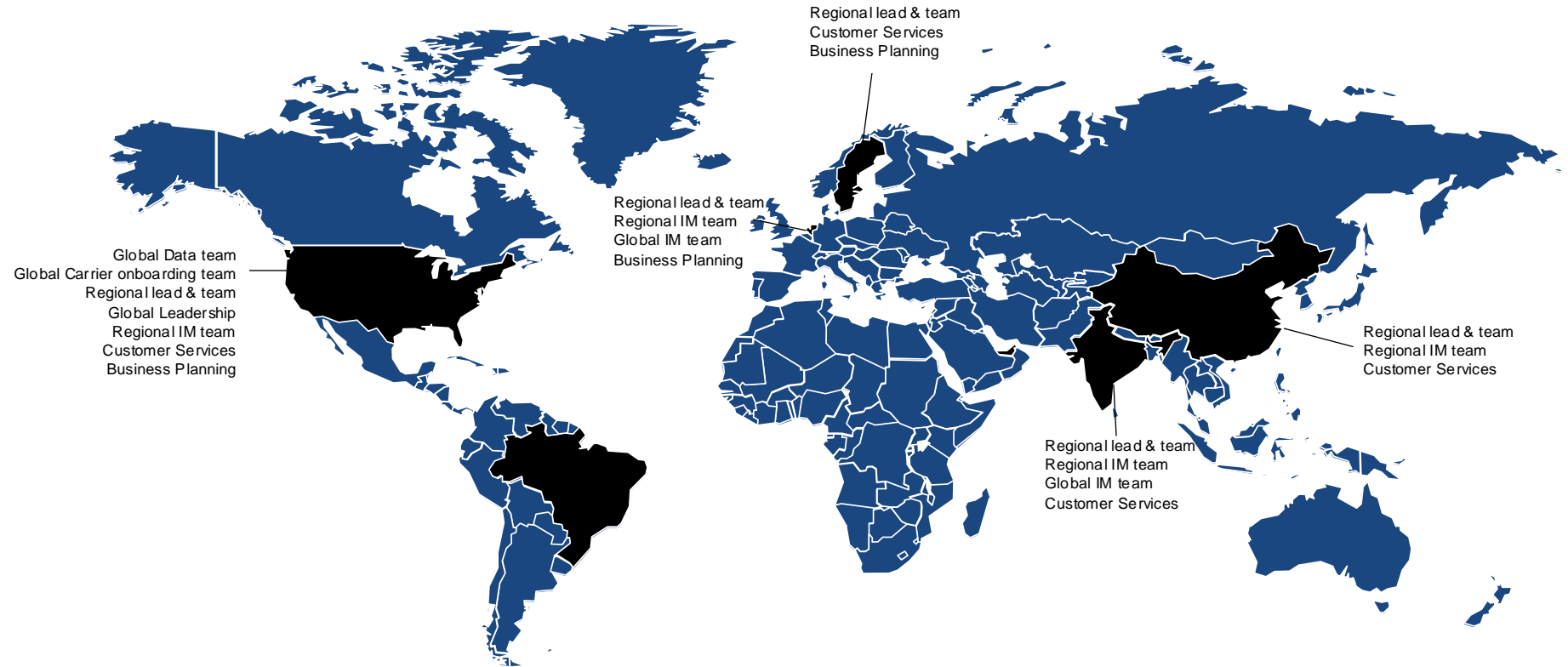

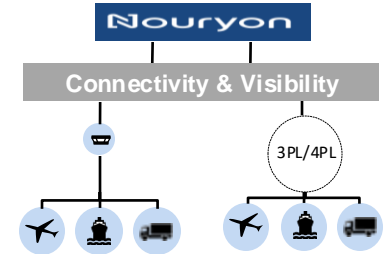

Using BNL and Descartes for Freight Collaboration

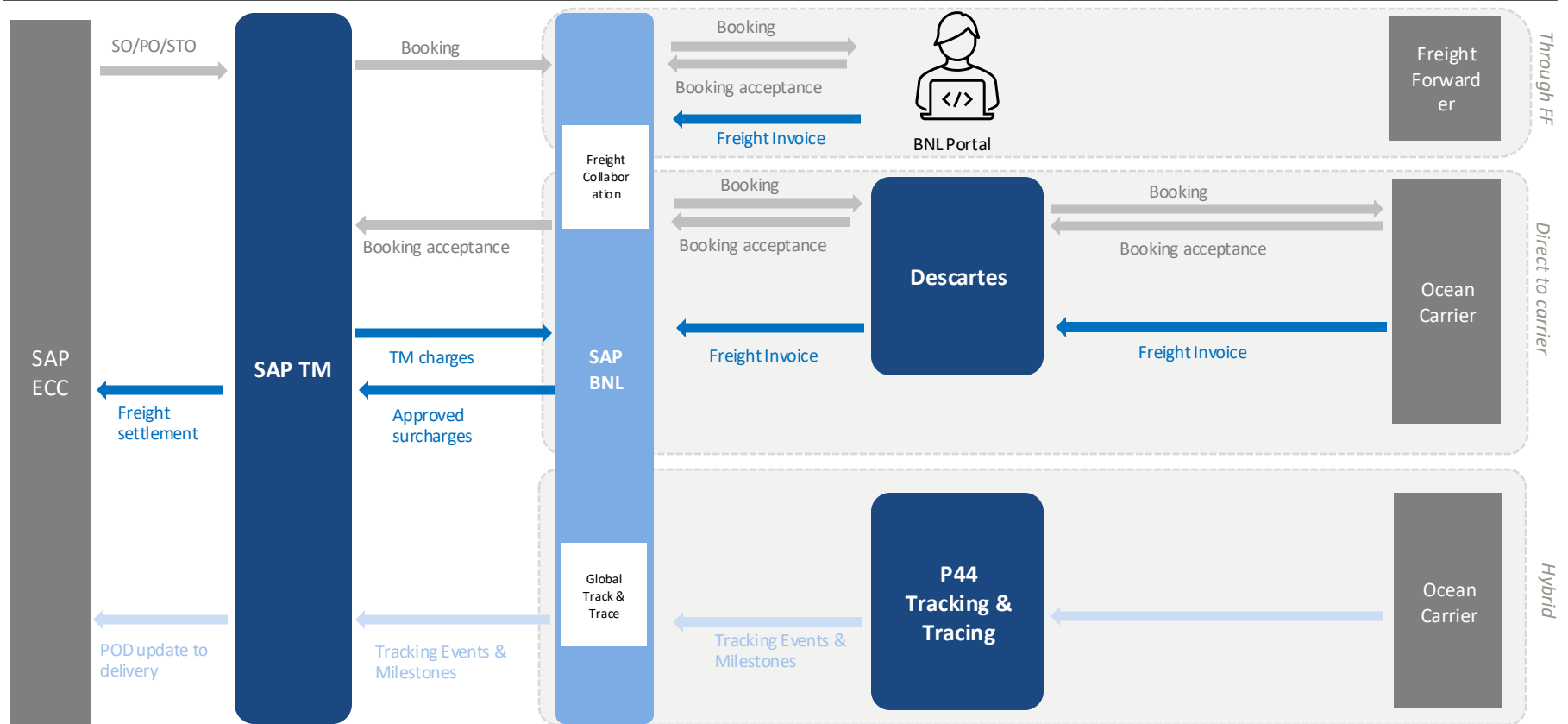
Using BNL and Descartes together because of hybrid model

- Nouryon decided to have a hybrid model:
 - Working with Freight Forwarders as well as directly dealing with carriers
- Ocean carriers will not work with portal solution, but will work with EDI/API connection
 - Limited time in project to roll out APIs
 - Descartes already has API integration with carriers and an integration with BNL
- BNL used for Freight Forwarder model
- Descartes for Carrier Direct model, Descartes function as Aggregator

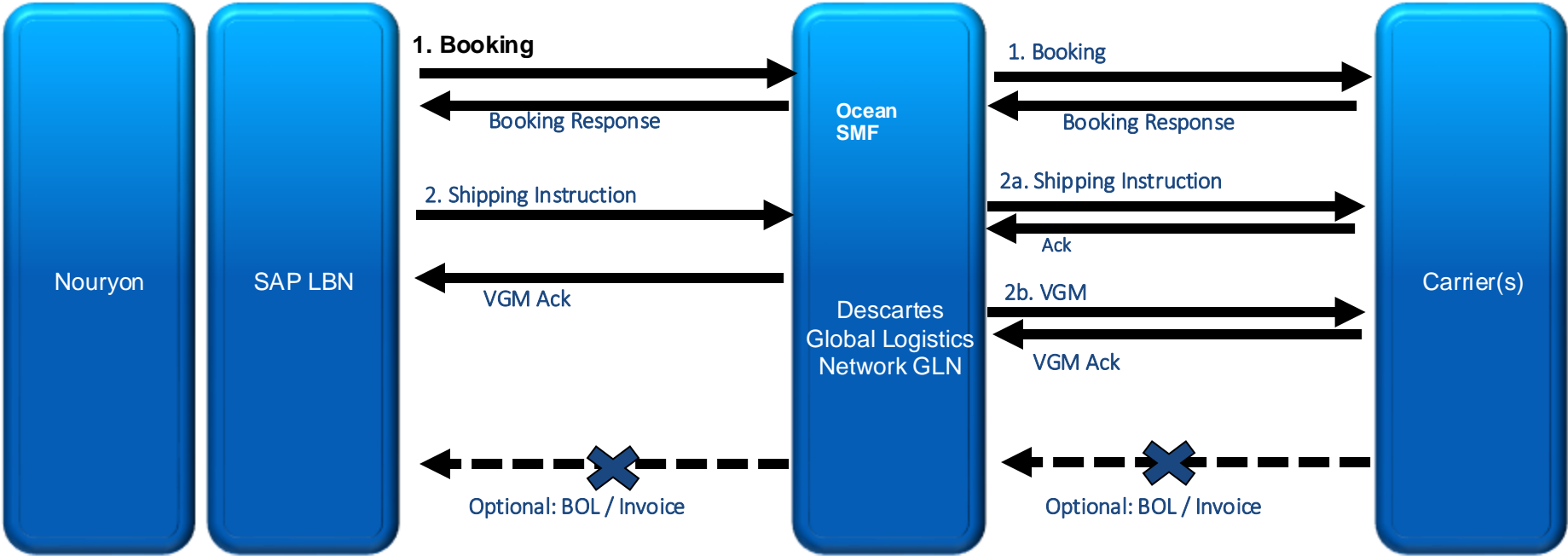


Landscape for SAP TM, SAP BNL, Descartes and P44

Main flows between the different platforms



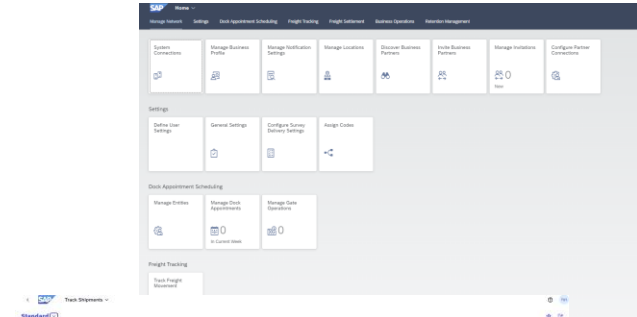

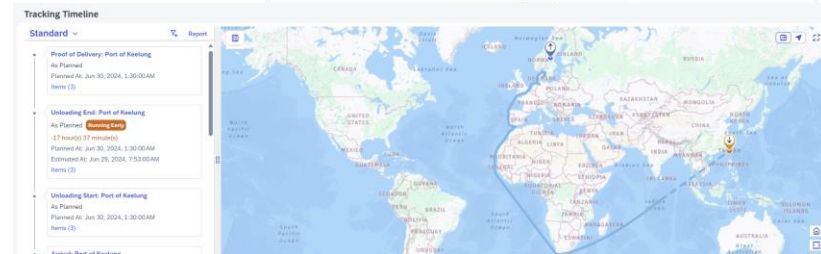
BNL Implementation

BNL is used for our FreightForwarder Model

- Process scope:
 - Collaboration
 - Freight Order placement and confirmation for road freight (pre – and on Carriage)
 - Freight Booking placement and confirmation for ocean freight and Door to Door arrangements
 - Global Track and Trace with P44 T&T information
 - Invoicing
 - Billing requests for Freight Orders and Freight Bookings
 - Invoicing from carriers
 - Disputes
- Organisational scope
 - Freight Forwarders
 - Road carriers, via FF
 - Tank Operators, via FF
- System scope
 - Portal
 - Started with this to enable quick ramp up with Freight Forwarder
 - Clear visibility on what to maintain
 - Manual entries, so cumbersome and error prone
 - API
 - Starting to implement now, priority was given to portal
 - Longer lead time to set up and test
 - Depending on willingness and ability of carrier to invest time
 - Once ready and stable: more robust and scalable



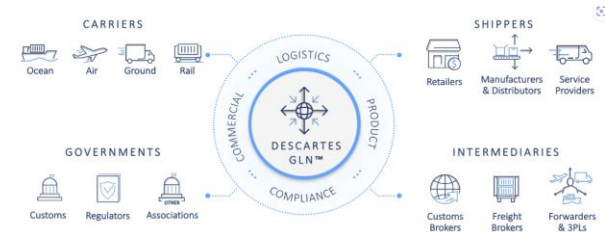

Descartes implementation

Used for our Carrier Direct Model

- Process scope:
 - Collaboration
 - Freight Order placement and confirmation for road freight (pre – and on Carriage)
 - Freight Booking placement and confirmation for ocean freight and Door to Door arrangements
 - Global Track and Trace with P44 T&T information
 - Invoicing
 - Billing requests for Freight Orders and Freight Bookings
 - Invoicing from carriers
 - Disputes
- Organisational scope
 - Road carriers
 - Tank Operators
- System scope
 - Descartes is set up as a network partner in BNL
 - Integration set up between ECC, TMS, BNL, Descartes dependent on standardization
 - Attention points: Incoterms, UN locodes, postal code zones standardisation, movement types

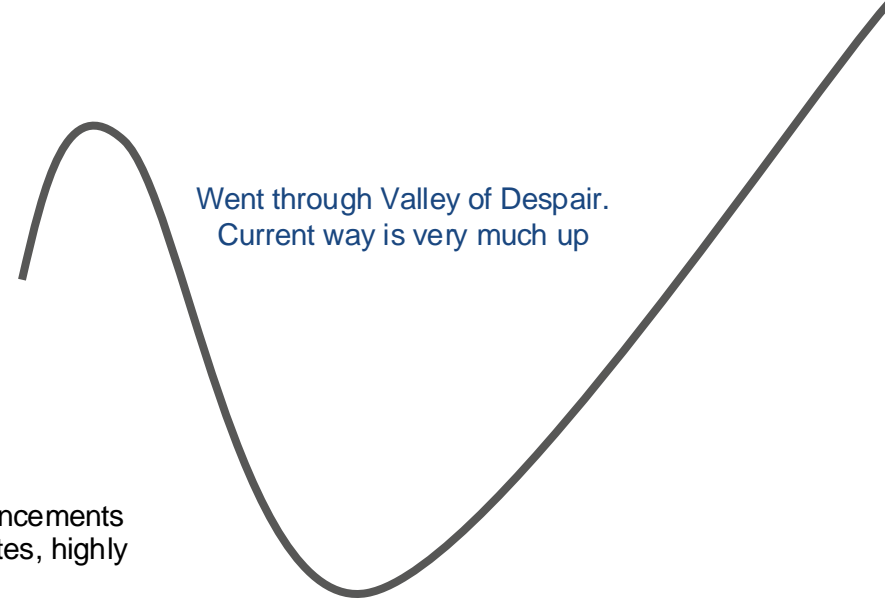
Key Success Factors

Delivered

- Robust Global Template and System set up, including almost 100 enhancements
- Solution and processes have been rolled out to all Regions and most sites, highly accelerated roll out in past months
- Process Harmonisation and Change Management are not on desired level yet
- Main benefits around customer satisfaction, control and productivity are expected to be delivered as of now with the solution in place and rolled out

Drove standardization with > 40 key decision documents but also delivered >100 developments to cover Nouryon specific business requirements providing:

- Flexibility to go carrier direct or via a freight forwarder in an automated way also providing direct, on-line booking solution for carriers and FF's.
- Fully automated end-to-end processes for sales orders and ICSTO's with dashboards to handle the exceptions
- Operational reports to manage logistics operations and do financial analyses, already for > 6.000 orders handled in TM

Delivered for 285 of 306 Shipping Points (~95% of order volume) in 6 Regions (APAC, IMEA, Nordics, Mainland, NAM, SAM)
