

Ralf Gilsbach

Ralf Gilsbach studied Pharmacy and received his PhD in Pharmacology and Toxicology in 2006 from the University of Bonn. For his post-doctoral work, he moved in 2006 to the University of Freiburg, where he received his Habilitation in Pharmacology and Toxicology (2012). In 2012, Ralf Gilsbach became a group leader at the University of Freiburg and focused his research on epigenetic mechanisms in cardiac myocytes. From 2019 to 2022, he was a professor for Cardiac Regulation at the Centre of Physiology, Goethe University Frankfurt. Since 2022, he has been a full professor at the Institute of Experimental Cardiology, Heidelberg University. His primary current research interest is the identification and steering of epigenetic mechanisms and chromatin organization in the context of cardiac development and disease.
