Dr. Kimber Simmons is a pediatric endocrinologist and physician-scientist at the Barbara Davis Center for Diabetes, University of Colorado. She directs the Early Type 1 Diabetes Clinic and Clinical Immunotherapy Program, where she leads early-stage T1D monitoring and real-world use of teplizumab. Dr. Simmons also leads Ask the Experts, a national resource supporting families and healthcare providers after positive T1D screening results.

She is also principal investigator for multiple prevention and new-onset clinical trials and is committed to advancing practical pathways for early detection, monitoring, and disease-modifying therapy in type 1 diabetes.
