Dr. Ramos is Heisenberg Professor for Cardio-Immunology and head of the Immunocardiology Lab at the Comprehensive Heart Failure Center / University Hospital of Würzburg, Germany. He obtained his PhD in Pharmacology (Federal University of Santa Catarina, Brazil) and habilitated in Experimental Cardiology (*venia legendi*) at the University Hospital of Würzburg, Germany. He is co-founder and deputy chair of the cardio-immunology working group within the German Society for Cardiology, and scientific coordinator of the Collaborative Research Centre “Cardio-immune interfaces” at the University of Würzburg. His research focuses on elucidating antigen-specific immunological mechanisms underlying myocardial diseases and post-myocardial infarction repair, with emphasis on cardiac regulatory T cells and heart-reactive antibodies.
