Dr. Ramos is Heisenberg Professor for Cardio-Immunology and head of the Immunocardiology Lab at the Comprehensive Heart Failure Center / University Hospital of Würzburg, Germany. He obtained his PhD in Pharmacology (Federal University of Santa Catarina, Brazil) and habilitated in Experimental Cardiology (venia legendi) at the University Hospital of Würzburg, Germany. He is co-founder and deputy chair of the cardio-immunology working group within the German Society for Cardiology, and scientific coordinator of the Collaborative Research Centre “Cardio-immune interfaces” at the University of Würzburg. His research focuses on elucidating antigen-specific immunological mechanisms underlying myocardial diseases and post-myocardial infarction repair, with emphasis on cardiac regulatory T cells and heart-reactive antibodies.
