

Ziad Mallat

Ziad Mallat is Professor of Cardiovascular Medicine at the University of Cambridge and a Research Professor at Inserm, France. He obtained his MD and specialist qualification in Cardiovascular Medicine from Pierre & Marie Curie University (University of Paris VI), and a PhD followed by HDR in cardiovascular immunology from Paris Diderot University (University of Paris VII). After serving as a consultant cardiologist in Versailles, he was appointed Director of Research at Inserm and has led internationally recognised programmes in cardiovascular immunology and inflammation. Mallat has published more than 330 peer-reviewed papers and his work has defined key pathogenic and regulatory immune pathways in atherosclerosis, post-ischaemic remodelling and aortic disease, informing new immuno-modulatory and vaccination-based therapies. His research integrates basic discovery, pre-clinical animal studies and proof-of-concept clinical trials in coronary artery disease. He serves on the editorial boards of leading journals, is co-Editor of *Atherosclerosis*, and has received multiple honours, most recently the 2025 Lucian Award.
