- **Sunday 2 August** - Sperm: Tiny Cell - Big Picture

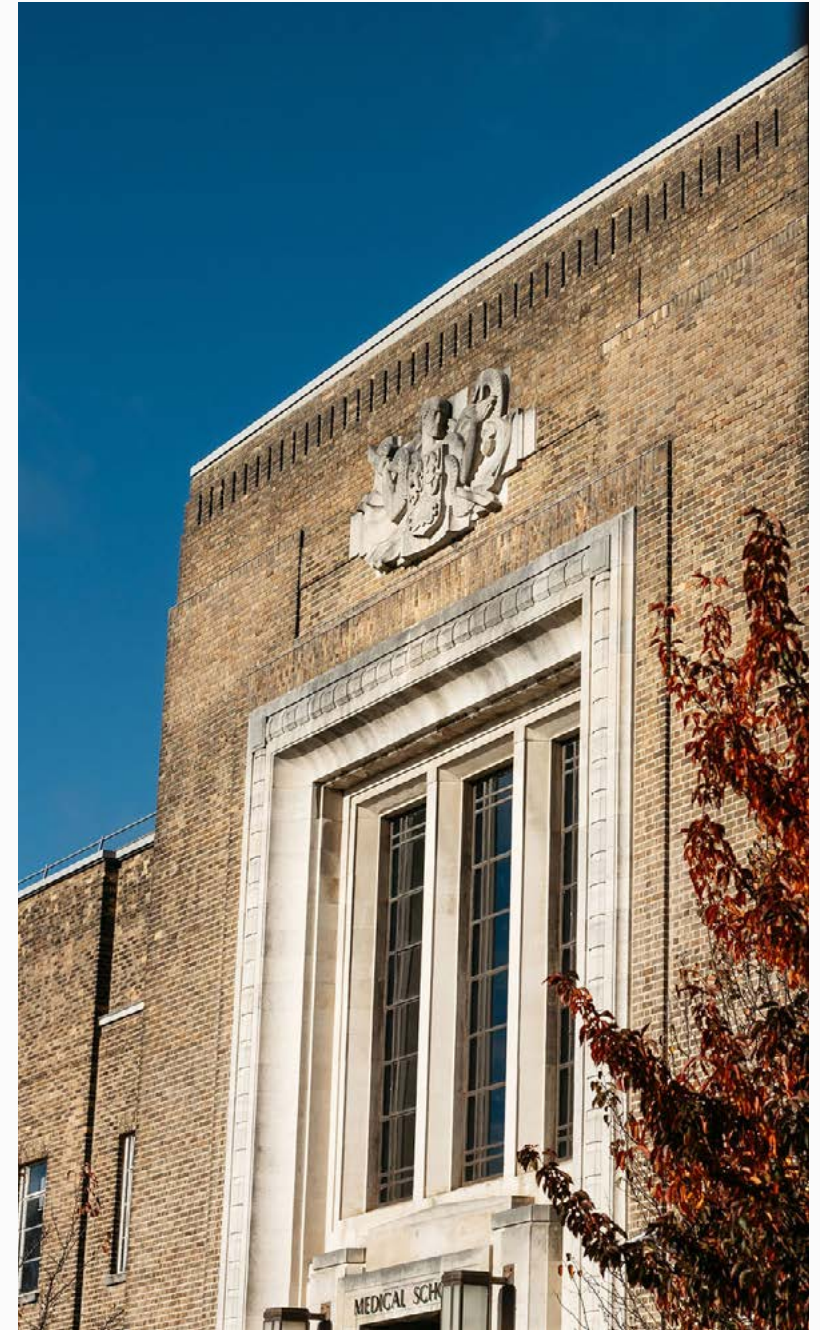


# The Centre for Human Reproductive Science at the University of Birmingham
