Dr Farouk Mamdoo graduated with an MBBCh from the University of Witwatersrand Medical School and obtained the FCP(SA) and Certificate in Cardiology(SA) and was awarded the Jock Gear Memorial Award and SA Heart Award for best oral congress presentation. He underwent training in Interventional Cardiology at the Washington Hospital Centre, (USA), Advanced Echocardiography at Aurora St. Luke's Medical Centre, (USA), Cardiac Synchronisation Therapy at Santa Maria Della Misericordia Hospital, (Italy).
