2025 PAINSA CONGRESS ABSTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

RULES FOR ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

- Presenting authors are expected to be registered and paid participants of the 2025 PainSA Congress.
- Abstracts must be of completed original scientific research (review articles will only be
 considered if they are registered systematic reviews), which has not been presented at other
 national or international scientific meetings, or which has been published. However, abstracts
 for work where previous presentation or publication was of preliminary data, and for which
 complete data are now available, will be eligible for presentation.
- Submission of an abstract acknowledges acceptance for the abstract to be listed in official meeting publications.
- Submission of an abstract acknowledges that all co-authors were made aware of the content of the abstract before submission.
- Submission of an abstract acknowledges that the presenting author undertakes to declare all disclosures and potential conflicts of interest in their presentation.
- Abstracts must be submitted in English.
- Abstracts must be received by the announced deadline in order to be considered.

HOW TO SUBMIT YOUR ABSTRACT

Use the abstract online form to submit your abstract.

The following information is required when submitting your abstract:

- Presenting author's contact details:
 - Email address
- Author and co-authors' details
 - o Full first and family name(s).
 - o Authors' names must be in the format: John C Doe.
 - Affiliation details: department, institution/hospital/practice, city, country.
- Abstract title limited to 20 words in UPPER CASE
- Abstract text limited to 250 words (note: do not include graphs/tables/images in the abstract)
- The abstract must be structured under the following sub-headings:
 - Background and aims
 - Methods
 - Results
 - o Conclusions
- Use only standard abbreviations. Place special or unusual abbreviations in parentheses after the full word appears the first time.
- Use generic names of drugs.
- Express numbers as numerals.

DISCLOSURES

Disclosure of financial relationships that the author(s) may have with the manufacturer/supplier of any commercial products or services related to the work, should be indicated in the appropriate box on the abstract form.
