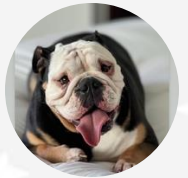
Our Journey



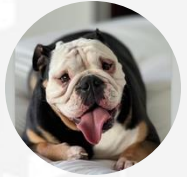
- Started with excel spreadsheet 2004-2013

What is Basecamp?

Basecamp is an online workspace where teams can manage projects, share files, assign tasks, and track progress. It's widely used by organizations, businesses, and student teams to replace scattered tools like email, shared drives, and messaging apps.



Why AS is Using Basecamp



- Clarity: Everyone knows what's happening and when.
- Teamwork: Marketing, programs, and advising collaborate seamlessly.
- Organization: Files, updates, and feedback in one place.
- Accountability: Each task has a name and a deadline.

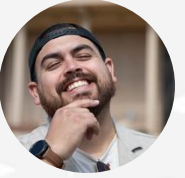
How Basecamp is Structured



Basecamp is organized by Projects (e.g., Big Show, Marketing Requests).

Each project includes:

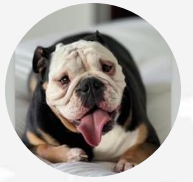
- Message Board – Discussions & announcements
- To-Dos – Tasks & deadlines
- Docs & Files – Flyers, videos, graphics
- Schedule – Timelines
- Campfire – Real-time chat
- Check-Ins – Regular updates
- Card Tables – Shows what stage project is currently in

Example: AS Event Planning

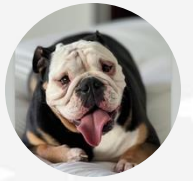


Example: Team Management

Cost



Free Option:

- You can run one project at a time/1GB of storage

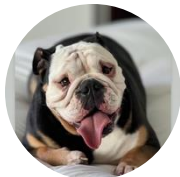
Basecamp Plus:

- Ideal for smaller teams – pay per user - \$15/user per month
- Unlimited projects
- 500 GB of storage

Basecamp Pro Unlimited

- This is the option we use – For the entire organization - \$1740/year
- Fixed price – unlimited users – unlimited projects – 5TB of storage
- Includes Admin Pro Pack upgrade
